

Concentration Requirements

A concentration is similar in concept to the minor but requires fewer credits for completion. Concentrations may be earned in fields unrelated to students' majors, or they may be complementary or supportive of majors.

Students may not earn a concentration without also earning or holding a Minot State University degree.

Pursuing a Concentration

A student may elect to earn one or more concentrations. Bachelor of Arts degree students pursuing two concentrations must earn at least one concentration outside their major content area.

Credits Required for a Concentration

Courses required for the concentration are specified by each discipline that offers one. Although the actual number of credits required to complete a concentration will vary by discipline, a minimum of nine credits has been established by the faculty for this purpose. Concentrations that include a minimum of 12 credits will be transcribed per SBHE Policy 409.

Grade Point Average Requirement

A minimum grade point average of 2.00 is required for the concentration(s). Some programs of study have higher minimum grade point average expectations. Refer to individual program guidelines for more information.
